Please note that the conference dinner will take place in the evening. Therefore, you may have to stay an additional night from Thursday 26 to Friday 27 – Please arrange your trip and accommodation accordingly.

#### 3- Book your accommodation yourself as soon as possible

The major hotels are located in the city center, about 5 kms from the conference venue. Several hotels are available. As a general rule these hotels are quite expensive if registration is made only a few days ahead. For instance the normal rate at a major hotel is 160€ per night. However, if you book your room immediately for March 2026, the price is about 120€. There is also the risk that rooms are no more available if you book late. Therefore, we strongly advise you to arrange your accommodation as soon as possible to save money and be sure to find rooms. The organisers do not care about accommodation. You need to book your hotel yourself, following your needs and preferences.

For your information, Bergamo Jazz Festival takes place from March 19 to 22. Therefore, if you have the intention to spend some time in the city for tourism, please be aware that it might be difficult to find accommodation over the weekend March 21-22.

#### **Transportation**

#### Air transportation

Bergamo is located just a few kilometers from the Milan-Bergamo airport called **Orio al Serio (BGY).** It is the third airport of Milan after **Malpensa** for international flights and **Linate** for many intra-Europe flights. Orio al Serio is served by low-cost airlines like Ryanair, Eurowings, Volotea, etc. At this airport, the ATB company operates the bus line N°1 every 20 minutes to the city, with many stops close to the major hotels. https://www.atb.bergamo.it/trasporti-pubblici/linee

#### Transfer between hotels and Kilometro Rosso

We organize a shuttle bus between Bergamo city center and Kilometro Rosso each morning and back in the evening. The bus will start from Excelsior San Marco and stop near the major hotels and the train station. The shuttle will also operate on March 23 afternoon to attend La Nuova Energia. For information, there is a hourly train service from Bergamo reaching the Stezzano station in 4 minutes. The Stezzano train station is located 700m from Kilometro Rosso. (Trains from Bergamo direction Treviglio, first stop).

#### 5- Workshop organisation

Abstract submission must be completed by pre-registration of at least one author. Final acceptance will require paid registration.

#### Oral presentations

The Organizers will notify the Authors of oral and poster presentations selected by the Scientific Committee, no later than January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026. The time slot for an oral presentation is 20 minutes plus 10 minutes for questions and answers. Presenters must prepare a Microsoft Power Point presentation that will be uploaded on the conference computer not later than Monday 23 March afternoon. You can send it by email or bring it on a USB key. The oral presentations will be recorded and subsequently uploaded on the ISCMNS YouTube channel. A copyright document will have to be signed.

#### Posters presentation

Posters maximum dimensions is A0: Height: 1189 mm x Width: 841 mm – They will be supported on vertical boards installed in the exhibition room. The posters must clearly present the research done and the main results. The font size of the texts should be 18-pt or larger.

Presenters are invited to print their own posters and bring them to the conference. We can have them printed for you on site at your expense provided that you send us your electronic file no later than March 2, 2026. Contact us for prices, acceptable formats and electronic transfer arrangements.

#### On-site exhibition

Before the IWALHM17 Workshop, participants will have the opportunity to contribute to an Exhibition that is open to the public, the press and VIPs from the industry and the authorities. The Exhibition is for the purpose of demonstrating the viability of Clean and Alternative Energy sources. This Exhibition will be opened on Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, through Wednesday, March 25th, 2025 at the same venue building. It is organized by Prometheus as a parallel event of La Nuova Energia and the IWAHLM17 workshop for a maximum of 10 exhibitors. Researchers and companies are encouraged to present their energy production devices and relevant research apparatuses.

Since the first announcement, and after further checking with the local authorities we have been informed that **only static devices**, **not operating and not energized** can be on display at the exhibition.

Each space will have one desk, having standard dimensions of approximately 160 x 75 cm, and every station will be equipped with the necessary electric sockets for a monitor and a laptop.

The exhibitors are invited to complement their exhibition with posters that explain the functioning of the systems with all necessary details for the understanding of non-specialist visitors and the public. Video monitors will be provided. Therefore, it is encouraged to prepare movies showing the systems in operation while at the original laboratories or factories, giving as much convincing information as possible, and avoiding obvious general statements about the need for new clean energy because all visitors will already be aware of that.

There is no charge for the exhibition.

All potential exhibitors must send the following information to the organisers **as soon as possible** because the number of exhibition spaces is limited to 10:

- General description of the equipment on display. The description will be introduced in the book of abstract
- Overall size and mass, booth space area requested
- Number and sizes of the posters

Please note the exhibition must be installed **before Monday March 23**, at noon. No installation activity in the exhibition hall will be possible after noon, when the conference **La Nuova Energia** starts.

#### **Proceedings**

The conference proceedings will be published in the Journal of Condensed Matter Nuclear Science. We encourage all speakers to submit a contribution to the proceedings. Poster contributions that are presented in person will also be eligible for being included in the proceedings. In order to maintain the desired quality standard, potential authors are reminded that only novel, original work should be submitted to the proceedings. All these papers will be peer reviewed.

The venue of the meeting is located at **Kilometro Rosso**, a **Science and Technology Park** that houses companies, high-tech production activities, research centres and laboratories.
